Old Business:

New Business:

- Joe K1JMA spoke about the standing request from John WI1G to members for donated equipment (in good working order) for sale at our clubs NEAR-Fest table. Please coordinate equipment donations with John. Paul KB1MTW also spoke about equipment sold on a consignment basis.
- Joe K1JMA reminded everyone about nominations for the four club officer and one director position (currently held by John WD1L). Nominations are to take place at this meeting and again at the May meeting. After the May meeting, nominations are closed as the election takes place at the June meeting. Jim W1JT nominated John WD1L for the director position, with John accepting. John WI1G nominated the current officers: Joe K1JMA, Jeff N1SOM, Larry W1VP and Paul KB1MTW for their currently held officer positions. The officers will announce their intention to accept or decline their nomination at the May club meeting.

- Ross W1EKG indicated he has NEAR-Fest tickets for sale after the meeting. Joe K1JMA asked the club membership for availability to help support the club equipment setup/take-down and table sales at NEAR-Fest. Joe also asked if we have any more details about the request to help clean up the fairgrounds area after the NEAR-Fest event. - Ross W1EKG provided training update:

 - Paul KB1MTW volunteered to contact the YMCA and arrange use of their field.
- Paul KB1MTW mentioned the current state of the Pine St. location is in need of landscape cleanup after the winter storms. Paul mentioned John WI1G volunteered to help with this.
