New Business:

- Joe K1JMA reminded everyone that Ross W1EKG has NEAR-Fest tickets for sale. Joe also reminded folks of the club request for donated working ham radio equipment items for sale on the club table at NEAR-Fest. Mike WA1MAD brought up the question of the expected sale price of equipment on the table. Joe indicated he would check for sale prices on Ebay of equivalent equipment if necessary. Paul KB1MTW additionally mentioned the club will still sell members equipment on a consignment basis and stressed a minimum sale price must be provided by the equipment owner.
- Joe K1JMA reminded everyone of the upcoming June election and this (May) meeting being the final chance for members to nominate folks for the officer positions (President, VP, Treasurer and Secretary) and the 2018 director seat. Jeff WK1D asked if no challengers to the incumbents exist, does the club in fact have to hold a voting session at all? Joe K1JMA indicated this is still necessary per our club bylaws.  - Paul KB1MTW confirmed use of the E-Bridgewater YMCA field.
 - o Bill N1FRE offered 2 propane gas tanks for use w/the grills at Pine St.
 - A general discussion took place on the need for Laptop replacements for electronic logging during Field Day operations. Joe K1JMA will investigate the options. Thanks to all members who offered these options.
 - **Jeff WK1D** indicated he has ARRL printed material (handouts) for the event.
 - The need for an event coordinator was discussed but no volunteers were identified yet.
 - A general discussion took place regarding Field Day announcements to the public for example on the clubs Facebook page. Heather W1AZU volunteered to work with Jeff N1ZZN to implement this info. Ross W1EKG further suggested a WATD radio mention of our Field Day event might be possible. Steve W1OD mentioned he was interviewed in the past by WATD Dave KB1QMX indicated a press release w/these details can be written and also volunteered to reach out to the Whitman/Hanson cable access folks.

- **Joe K1JMA** indicated he still has club jackets ordered for members who requested them. These need to pick these up and paid for ASAP. Summer items (T-shirts, etc) won't be ordered until the jacket order is closed.
- Paul KB1MTW mentioned the upcoming Boy Scout event at the E-Bridgewater YMCA field on Saturday May12 where he plans to demonstrate amateur radio (VHF and HF hopefully). Paul is looking for a few volunteers to help him. A general discussion followed regarding the Boy Scout youth protection program and the CORI (Criminal Offender Record Information) check process.
