Treasurer, **Jeff N1SOM** read the April 2015 treasurers report. Motion to accept the report as read made by Jeff N1ZZN with a second by John W1JGR. Motion passed guorum vote. A question regarding the profit earned from equipment sales at the spring NEARFEST event was asked. **Paul KB1MTW** reported sales of \$828 minus the consigment cost (\$657) paid to the equipment owners resulting in \$171 profit.

The April 2015 secretary's report was published on the club website. Motion to accept the report as published made by **Jeff WK1D**, with a second from **Joe K1JMA**. Motion passed quorum vote.

New Business:

- Upcoming club elections:
 - Jim W1JT reminds everyone ballots for the upcoming club election will be mailed out soon by Jeff N1SOM to club members who have paid their club dues. Members w/an outstanding dues payment will not recieve a ballot and cannot vote in this years election.
 - Bill N1FRE remided everyone nominations for club officers ends at the conclusion of tonights meeting- and as yet we do not have a nomination for the club president position. Bill suggests the board of directors could act as president if necessary, selecting one board member to act as president when needed. A general discussion followed.

- Billy K1UFO nominated John WI1G for president. John accepted the nomination!
- **Bill N1FRE** nominated **Ron KB10EQ** for the board of the directors postion. Ron accepted the nomination!
- **Garry AB1CQ** nominated **John WD1L** for the board of directors position. John accepted the nomination!
- Chris N1CFB updated the club members on the current status for the clubs upcoming Flea Market (May30th and 31st, 8am-3pm rain or shine at the K/C hall in Whitman MA).
 - Jack N1BCE has donated double sided event signs! (Thanks Jack!). Chris N1CFB will have these soon for anyone who is willing to place these around in area towns. The signs should be placed one week before the Flea Market (during the Memorial Day weekend)
 - **Chris N1CFB** tells us a few vendors have signed on (half a dozen approx) but more are needed.
 - Bill N1FRE suggests the yellow Flea Market flyers be dropped off at area stores and supermarket bulletin boards. Also these can be taped into your car windows. Roy KB1CYV, Jack N1BCE, John WI1G, Wayne KB1YFQ, Bob KA1KIJ and Jeff WK1D offered to take yellow flyers and distribute into area stores. A general discussion took place on other locations including other flea markets where flyers could be given out. Joe K1JMA indicated the Genesis club will be including our Flea market details in their club newsletter.
 - **Jim NM1N** will be attending a Flea Market at the K/C hall this weekend and will give out flyers.
 - **Jim W1JT** will investigate placing a Craigs List ad and also look at placing free ads in local area newspapers.
 - Jeff N1ZZN suggests the Whitman/Hanson express newspaper should place the ad for free in their community event section. Jeff will also investigate advertising on the Whitman/Hanson cable channel. Possibly the radio station WATD might provide free advertisement. Chris N1CFB will investigate. It's agreed Bill N1FRE's Flea Market flyer will be used as the template for newspaper ads.
 - Chris N1CFB advises that vendor costs for Flea Market space will \$20 on Saturday and \$15 on Sunday. Vendors can leave a msg on the clubs voice-mail system (781-523-5010) or email to <u>WA1NPO@gmail.com</u>. Jeff N1ZZN will forward emails to Chris N1CFB. For folks w/last years Flea Market signs, Chris tells us he has date strips showing May 30/31st which will cover over last years dates.
 - It was decided the clubs repeater will periodically announce the Flea Market event.
 Elayne KB1IKH volunteered to record the announcement. Chris N1CFB will provide the script. Jeff N1ZZN will record the msg and install it on the repeater controller. It was decided the announcement will be made 5 minutes after the last activity on the repeater.
 - Chris N1CFB reviewed items the club will have for sale.
 - HF station from AI Craddock WA1ZKK
 - a 2 meter beam antenna from **Jim WG1L**
 - hand held tape measure/Fox hunt 2 meter beam antennas
 - assorted other donated equipment

Old Business:

- Jeff N1ZZN informed us of the new coax/hardline jumper he purchased for use on the Whitmans clubs repeater in an effort to improve its performance. Jumper & connectors/parts total approx \$164. Motion to pay Jeff N1ZZN for these parts made by Bill N1FRE with a second by Joe K1JMA. Motion passed quorum vote. Motion to allocate funds (approx \$100) to hire a climber to install these parts made by Billy K1UFO with a second by Jeff WK1D. Motion passed quorum vote.
- Paul KB1MTW suggests using the MARA/Bridgewater (147.180) repeater during times the Whitman repeater is not usable (ex: during the Sunday WARC public service net)w/permission of the MARA club. Barry N1EZH (MARA club president) agreed and will inform the MARA club members via email to expect Whitman club net operations from time to time.
- **Ross W1EKG** informed us the recent CranLand field operation/net control went well. Also this springs NEAR-Fest event went well.
- **Paul KB1MTW** gave us a Pine Street/Quonset hut update:
 - The top of the antenna tower has rusted off and antenna is now hanging down. A general discussion took place regarding other tower options (Bob Pratts tower, Bob Johnsons tower pending Mrs Johnsons approval). Also mentioned was Al Craddocks tri-band beam needs to be taken down.
 - Paul KB1MTW tells us flooring material is available for use in the quonset hut. Billy K1UFO, Fred KC1ACG, Dave KC1QMX and Bill KC1CNP volunteered to help w/the flooring project.
- Roy KB1CYV brought to everyones attention the <u>Dollars for Scholars</u> program and asked if we intend to make our typical (\$500) donation to the Whitman/Hanson high school. A general discussion took place. A motion to donate \$500 this year to the <u>Dollars for Scholars</u> program made by Jeff WK1D with a second by Joe K1JMA. Motion passed quorum vote.
