

New Business:

- Paul KB1MTW informed the membership the old portable canopy used at the fair finally fell apart and was disposed of. A general discussion took place on purchasing a replacement. The general thought was to purchase an 'Easy Up' brand due to it's quality and ease of setup/use. Several members offered to investigate purchasing options (Jeff WK1D, Billy K1UFO, Bill N1FRE). The group determined a 12' x 12' size would be ideal but no smaller than 10' x 10' and we will need it for NEAR-FEST on October 16th & 17th. Motion to allocate \$200 (max) for purchase of a new canopy made by Bill N1FRE with a second by Jeff N1ZZN. Motion passed quorum vote.
- Paul KB1MTW commented he recently visited John Coombs WQ1L and his wife Pat
 and they are doing ok. Paul noted John has kindly donated a large amount of beam
 antenna parts. Anyone needed beam antenna parts, please see Paul.
- Jeff N1ZZN provided an update regarding use of the Hanson tower as a future club repeater site. He along with Mark KC1ACF, Kevin KB1MOC, Fred KC1ACG and Billy K1UFO attended a recent selectmen meeting. Jeff indicated they were very positive on the idea and would be seeking additional approvals from other town departments (legal, etc..). Jeff also indicated the repeater is working fine at it's current temporary location. John K1JRO announced our new Yaesu Fusion repeater has just arrived and will transfer it to Jeff N1ZZN after the meeting.
- Chris N1CFB provided an update on the upcoming fall Flea Market scheduled for Saturday/Sunday September 26th and 27th, 8am-3pm at the K/C hall. Chris provided orange flyers w/the details. Chris also has some smaller flyers. Vendor cost is \$20 Sat/

\$15 Sunday as before. **Jeff N1ZZN** indicated he sent emails out to the local public service/cable tv contact and to the Whitman/Hanson express newspaper w/the Flea Market details. Chris indicated several vendors have signed up already with more calling in on the clubs v-mail phone number. Chris also indicated the yard signs are at the club house and he'll be changing the dates on these asap. Chris will connect w/**Paul KB1MTW** to get the signs.

- John O'Neill K1JRO provided an update on the upcoming Run To The Rock road race in Plymouth on September 12th from 9am-12Noon approx. More volunteers are needed for race communications support. Email John at SSHARC@ gmail.com to help out. Please provide your t-shirt size as well. Volunteers meet at the McDonalds at the Rt3 Exit 5 rest stop that morning at 7-7:30am to coordinate w/John and pickup their t-shirt.
- Paul KB1MTW commented on the upcoming NEAR-FEST event on October 16th and 17th in Deerfield NH. Paul proposed folks could sell their equipment on consignment on the clubs table with approx 10% staying w/the club. Paul suggested folks could bring this equipment to be sold to next months meeting. Chris N1CFB confirmed he'll be at NEAR-FEST early to help with the club area setup.
- Joe K1JMA updated everyone on the plans to establish our special event operations during Thanksgiving weekend at Plimouth Plantation. Communications w/their management will be started asap. Joe requests club authorization to spend club funds if necessary and also copies of last years event logs showing international contacts specifically. A general discussion took place, including questions on where within the Plantation will we be setting up (Admin building, visitors center, Hornblower house?).
 Paul KB1MTW suggests asking for access to the balcony above the visitors center entrance for antenna placement of the clubs R5 and 2meter beam. Paul also reminded everyone that last year, the Plantation management suggested we run the event on the weekend before the Thanksgiving weekend. Jim W1JT suggests we consider alternate Plymouth locations as a backup just in case. John K1JRO suggests the Boys/Girls club might be an option as it's at a high elevation. Various other Plymouth locations were discussed, including waterfront/dockside near the Mayflower- althought crowds and weather concerns were raised. Jeff N1ZZN confirmed he submitted the event details to QRZ magazine with the event call sign N11X.
- Steve W10D mentioned he happen to meet former club member Paul Sowsy W1GRN. Steve reports Paul is doing fine and send best wished to the club and it's members.
- Paul KB1MTW opened a general discussion about installation of a 60' fold-over tower and 3-band, 5-element beam in excellent condition at the Pine St. club house (Al Craddocks recently deinstalled beam. (See pictures below, after the secretary notes). It was noted an adapter plate would be needed for the existing base at Pine St. (John WD1L indicated he can be of help with this. Billy K1UFO offered to help as well along with Bill N1FRE). The tower is most likely a Rohn 25. Paul noted Pete Carlson N1POO is storing Bob Johnsons Rohn 25 tower as well (comprised of 12 10' sections). It was suggested we check tower prices at the upcoming NEAR-FEST to help price this one for sale in the spring. Jeff N1ZZN suggested we organize a tower

take-down event at **Bill N1FRE's** QTH. (3 20' crank up sections, w/2" schedule 40 at the top along w/a StationMaster antenna). Bill expressed safety concerns when taking this down. Members volunteering for antenna/tower work include **Billy K1UFO**, **Mark KC1ACF**, **Paul KB1MTW**, **John WI1G** and **Steve W1OD**. Also mentioend was **Bob Pratts** tower which also needs to be taken down..

Motion to adjourn the meeting made by **Joe K1JMA**, with a second by **Jeff WK1D**. Motion passed quorum vote.
