Whitman Amateur Radio Club Field Day June 22-23, 2019

A weekend of outdoor fun and radio exploration is planned for Field Day 2019, hosted by WARC, the Whitman Amateur Radio Club. The WARC Field Day takes place at the East Bridgewater YMCA's Camp Satucket, 635 Plymouth Street, Route 106, from 2:00PM Saturday, June 22nd to 2:00PM Sunday, June 23rd.

Anyone who is curious about radio communications and amateur radio is welcome to visit or to join the event. You need not be a licensed ham radio operator, a member of WARC or the ARRL to participate. A licensed ham radio operator will be available to explain Field Day events, answer questions and to assist visitors interested in getting on the air.

At least four WARC club operating ham radio positions will be set up in the Camp Satucket Pavillion. Other club members will set up additional operating stations in the woods and fields of Camp Satucket and many will be on the air under the club's Special Event call sign, NI1X. Operators will explore and be ready to explain radio operations in a variety of operating modes.

The WARC Field Day is part of the annual amateur radio field day operating event sponsored by the ARRL, the American Radio Relay League. The goal of ARRL's national Field Day event is to use radio communications to make and gather contacts with other amateur radio operators located at other Field Day sites across the U.S.A. and around the world. Ham operators are encouraged to use portable systems and power while making contacts.
