**TECHNICAL PRESENTATION:** Paul Swartz N1FWD brought a service monitor to the September meeting and demonstrated the devise as he measured the sensitivity, output power, voice modulation (deviation) and frequency of the handheld and mobile rigs the members had brought with them.


