

#### Old Business

**Joe K1JMA** informed everyone that 30% of the club membership has still not paid their 2017 club dues. Joe encouraged all who have not paid, to please do so asap. (note: dues checks can be mailed to: Post Office Box 48 Whitman, MA 02382. Club membership is \$25/yr. Please include your callsign on the checkthx)

### New Business:

- Ross W1EKG announced he will have NEAR-Fest tickets for sale soon. The price this year will be a \$10 entrance fee & \$10 for inside parking. When available, a club wide email blast will be sent out. Joe asked who has the (2) early entry passes? It was noted **John WI1G** has one pass. The other has been lost.
- **Joe K1JMA** asked for volunteers going to NEAR-Fest to help setup and take down the clubs tables, the equipment for sale and the large tent. Joe K1JMA volunteered on both Friday and Saturday. Mike WA1MAD and Mark KC1ACF volunteered to help with take down. More volunteers are needed. Please speak

to Joe K1JMA, John WI1G or Paul KB1MTW to help out.

- Ross W1EKG provided an update on the Go-Kit symposium he is planning. New locations (and dates) are now being considered for this event. More info will be provided when available. (note, post meeting, June 17<sup>th</sup> seems to be the new date for the symposium. More details to follow when available)
- Mark KC1ACF provided an update on the Field Day event. Mark has not signed the contract with the Bridgewater YMCA yet for use of their fields but plans to do so tomorrow or Friday (April 6<sup>th</sup> or 7<sup>th</sup>). Mark will also confirm placement of signs on the YMCA property up to 1 week prior to the event. A general discussion took place on sign options. The 'sandwich' board sign stored at the clubhouse was mentioned but needs painting etc. to be usable. Joe K1JMA asked for volunteers to work on the 'sandwich' board to make it usable for this and other events (repainting, etc. needed). No volunteers came forward so Joe volunteered to do this. Also mentioned was possibly contacting Jack Foley N1BCE for his expertise on the matter. Joe K1JMA volunteered to speak with Jack. Mark also discussed his plans for again hosting a welcome center under his canvas tent near the lower pavilion. A general discussion took place on if & how we might also establish a GOTA (Get On The Air) station at the welcome center. Jeff **N1ZZN** informed us of additional rules the ARRL specifies for GOTA stations. It was decided to address this at the next club meeting after the rules have been reviewed. Jeff N1ZZN offered to contact the Whitman/Hanson Express newspaper to have our Field Day event listed with other community events.
- Steve W1OD inquired about the food budget for the Field day event. A general discussion took place with a motion to appropriate up to \$400 for food & supplies made by Ron KB1OEQ with a second by Ross W1EKG. Motion passed quorum vote. Joe K1JMA asked for volunteers to help Steve with the food preparations. John WD1L and Larry W1VP volunteered to help. Paul KB1MTW confirmed the grills will be transported to the Field Day site and will have filled propane gas tanks. Steve also reminded everyone of the Saturday 1pm VE session during Field Day. Mark KC1ECF also informed folks John W1JDG has again volunteered to be our Field Day safety officer.
- Joe K1JMA reminded everyone that club officer nominations should be done at this April meeting and the May club meeting. Nominations for President, Vice-President, Treasurer and Secretary are needed. Also one board member position will become available and should also have a nomination. Nominations for Joe K1JMA (President), Paul KB1MTW (Vice-President), Jeff N1SOM (Treasurer), Larry W1VP (Secretary) and Mike WA1MAD (board member) made by Brad W1AY with a second by Ryan KD1X. Motion passed quorum vote.
- Jeff N1SOM presented details on Jacket, T-Shirts and Polo-Shirts from Rockland Athletics:
  - Jackets: \$49.50 (S-XL), +\$2 (XXL), if quantity >6 ordered, \$48/ea
  - o T-Shirts: (quantity 20 or more) \$16 with club logo, \$20 +name and callsign
  - Polo Shirt: (quantity 15 or more) \$20 with club logo, \$24 +name and calls

- **Joe K1JMA** contacted a different vendor for comparison purposes:
- Jacket: \$45 (S-XXL), +\$3 (XXXL) includes club embroidery + name/callsign
- Jacket w/hood: \$50 (S-XXL), +\$3 (XXXL) includes same embroidery
- Ball caps: \$10 & \$15 w/club logo
- A \$60-\$65 setup fee is also required
- Also simple 1-color t-shirts with club logo on the front: \$6, +back logo \$8
- A general discussion took place regarding these options. Mike WA1MAD asked about club vests.
- **Joe K1JMA** started a general discussion regarding installation of our 2 meter repeater antenna at our current repeater site. It was decided to table the idea for now and open the topic up again at a later time.
- Paul KB1MTW decided to auction off his ARRL Hints & Kinks book. High bid went to Jeff WK1D for a \$25 donation to the club.
- Joe K1JMA started a general discussion on the topic of moving the club to a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization based on a discussion at a recent executive board meeting. Federal and State filings must take place & the club bylaws must be appended for this to take place. Additional changes such as raising the club dues were tabled for the time being while the 501(c)(3) details and bylaw changes can be investigated. Joe K1JMA and Jeff N1SOM explained a fundamental advantage of being a 501(c)(3) is our ability to accept donations as a non-profit organization and the inherent tax advantage to those who donate to the club.
  - Mike WA1MAD suggested Jack Foley N1BC might be of help in understanding the advantages of becoming a 501(c)(3)
  - A true non-profit/501(c)(3) can also receives business donations (ex: Stop&Shop food donations) and would have sales tax exclusion. Ryan KD1X suggested checking on a non-profit discount on rented space used by the club.
  - Other related topics included **John W1JDG** suggested a new Life membership club option be considered if/when re-writing the club by-laws to bring in cash to the club.
  - Motion to start the club bylaw update process to become 501(c)(3) compliant should the decision to move forward with the 501(c)(3) be made in the future made by John W1JDG with a second by Jeff WK1D. Motion passed quorum vote. John W1JDG volunteered to help with the club bylaw updating.
  - Billy K1UFO suggested the current club bylaws be made available for all club members (via our website) as many club members are not familiar with these.
  - Dave KB1QMX suggested consulting a local attorney when the time is right.
  - Bob N1COP suggested retaining a CPA for the 501(c)(3) transition. Bob also had suggestions for handling the 501(c)(3) investigation and transition through a smaller set of folks setup in a committee.
  - Jeff N1ZZN asked about the membership fee if attending any one of Ross's training classes. Joe K1JMA addressed this and indicated this policy will no longer be in place.
- It was announced the South Shore Repeater Associations 147.300Mhz repeater

in Weymouth is up and functioning.

- **Gary KC1JRA** President of the Wingbusters flying club announced an open house on June 4<sup>th</sup> 9am-3pm, at their flying field and invited the Whitman club to attend. Gary mentioned a Model-T club will also be attending.
- Ross W1EKG indicating he will be starting an Extra level training class very soon on Tuesday nights at the Whitman police station.
- John KC1FWV suggested started an Elmer program. (John is scheduled to talk about his ideas for this at the May club meeting)
- Dave KB1QMX noticed on one of the Whitman-Hanson cable access channels, a technician training class by Eric KB1FHS
- Paul KB1MTW reminded everyone the club has several towers and parts for sale. Also Bill N1FRE's tower needs to be taken down at some point as well.

Motion to adjourn the meeting made by **Mark KC1ACF** with a second by **Steve W1OD**. Motion passed a quorum vote.

### **New Business:**

- Joe K1JMA informed everyone that 79% of the club membership has now paid their 2017 dues and will be eligible to vote in the upcoming club election. 21% of the club membership have not paid and have now lost their voting and motion privileges. Joe also noted, this meeting is the last opportunity for anyone to make nominations for the club officer positions and the one board member position becoming available. Jeff WK1D nominated Steve W1OD for the board member position. A second was made by Brad W1AY. Steve W1OD accepted the nomination. Jeff N1SOM indicated ballots would be mailed out within a week.
- Joe K1JMA asked if John KC1FWV was present. (he was not). John had asked for time to give a talk after the meeting regarding a mentoring program for new amateur operators. Joe noted this will be postponed to a later meeting when John is available.
- Joe K1JMA asked for a show of hands regarding who would be attending the upcoming NEAR-Fest event on May 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup>. Approx 10-12 members indicated they would be attending the event. Joe indicated a sign-up sheet is available at the front table for times to man the Whitman club table and also to help with setup and breakdown of the table and equipment for sale. Paul KB1MTW described the new indoor location for the Whitman clubs table. Paul indicated the large club canopy is available for use by any club member. John W1JDG offered help load gear for club members needing assistance. Please contact John if you would like his help (thanks John!). Paul KB1MTW also mentioned anyone wishing to have equipment sold at the Whitman club table, please see him asap. Ross W1EKG indicated he now has NEAR-Fest tickets for sale (\$10 entrance fee, \$10 inside parking). Ross also mentioned an individual (Ron Smith, N1PXX) is looking for a ride up to NEAR-Fest. Contact Ross if you can help.
- Larry W1VP reports the website committee (Larry W1VP, John WD1L, Steve

**KV1SMC**, **Jeff N1ZZN**, **Justin KC1GEO and John KC1FWV**) is looking at other area club websites for ideas on improving our website. Further discussions are needed before we can begin the redesign. The attending committee members plan to meet after this meeting to discuss this further (**Larry W1VP**, **John WD1L** and **Steve KV1SMC**).

- Ross W1EKG indicated he will be running an informational/educational Go-Kit symposium June 17<sup>th</sup> 9am-12pm at the United Methodist Church, 503 South Ave Whitman MA. He explained this will be an opportunity for anyone with a Go-Kit to to highlight it's features and share details on its assembly and operation. Also Mike WA1MAD and Chris N1CFB may show their BITX 40Meter kits they've recently built. Ross will be working on the advertising of this event asap. Paul KB1MTW suggested he might bring some PL259 connectors and coax and show anyone interested the proper way to prep the coax and solder/assemble the PL259s. Paul also indicated there was a thought of setting up VHF/UHF and HF antennas at the church so go-kit stations could be operated during the event. John W1JDG offered to bring his HF antenna to the event. Ross also mentioned bringing Whitman club membership forms to the event as well.
- Ross W1EKG provided an update on the ongoing Extra training class. Things
  are going along pretty well with approx 7 folks attending. After this, the next
  series of classes will start in the fall.
- Mark KC1ACF provided an update on the Field Day 2017 event.
  - Mark has assured the contract with the Bridgewater YMCA for our use of their field on June 24<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup> has been signed.
  - Mark also mentioned he's acquired additional signs for the lower pavilion area better identifying this event to the visiting public.
  - It was mentioned Jeff N1ZZN would be have a mention of this event made in the Whitman-Hanson Express newspaper (Jeff N1ZZN to provide an update when available).
  - Mark further commented on his plan to submit an article on the event to the Patriot Ledger and Enterprise newspapers community service sections (as free submissions).
  - Mark plans to bring his trailer & generator as he did last year and operate at the lower pavilion.
  - Mark received permission to place signs along the front of the YMCA property as long as they <u>do not obscure a drivers view of rt 106 in either direction</u> when leaving the YMCA parking lot. The signs must be secured well (with rope and stakes if necessary) as the roadside is very windy along rt 106. The signs can be put in place up to 1 week prior to the event as well.
  - Mark also has the TV antenna recently purchased by John W1JDG for use with the signs to attract the general public to the event.
  - Joe K1JMA asked for a volunteer to store the extra non-perishable items after Field Day. Jim W1JT volunteered store space for this (Thanks Jim!).
  - Paul KB1MTW assured the grills will be delivered to the site and will check on the propane tanks to see if they need to be filled.
- Joe K1JMA mentioned he is assembling a committee to do a feasibility study on

moving the club to a 501(c)(3) non-profit status. Anyone interested in participating in the committee, please see Joe.

- Richard AG1B provided details on an upcoming FoxHunt planned for May 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> in Rochester MA This will include use of the automated FoxBox over both days as well as a person acting as the fox, transmitting every 5 minutes for 30 seconds on Saturday. Richard expects the live hunt to assemble at 10am and run from 10:30am-12pm on Saturday. Full details will be posted on the club website. There will be prizes for the winners as well (including a gift certificate for a local food establishment and a Baofung HT)
- Jack W1AKN announced an upcoming Boy Scout activity this Saturday May 6<sup>th</sup> from 9am-5pm at the Plymouth airport in conjunction with the Genesis Amateur Radio Society. The boy scouts will be looking for contacts on the N1ZIZ 146.685 Mhz repeater and also on 28.400Mhz ssb. Anyone who could standby on either of these frequencies for QSO's to help the Boy Scouts would be very much appreciated.

Motion to adjourn the meeting made by **Steve W10D** with a second by **Brad W1AY**. Motion passed a quorum vote.




