#### Old Business:

Bill N1FRE reviewed the recent Marshfield Fair event, thanking everyone who participated and commenting on the hope for more participation from the club membership. The club thanked Bill for his continued dedication to this event, it's organization and his time spent talking w/kids at the Fair on the club repeater. John WI1G commented the event went very well and wished for more member participation also. A brief discussion took place on the noticeable drop in booth visits when the Fairs scavenger hut flyers ran out. Ross W1EKG commented he did run the Wednesday night 28.333Mhz ragchew net from the Fair. A mention was also made of the lack of a Waterfall signal display planned for the booth. A general discussion took place on possible improvements/ changes for next years event. **Jim W1JT** suggested using HF digital mode(s) on the stations at the Fair. A general discussion took place and the advantages were noted: much less susceptible to bad band conditions, area noise from the Fair operations (aka Tractor Pull) will not affect the operators ability to make QSO's, QRP operation would be possible, FLDigi and other commonly used tools provide a signal waterfall display - useful for engaging the public. **Jeff N1ZZN** suggested **Jim** W1JT give a demo of this at an upcoming meeting.



I traveled to Harrison, OH in August to participate in the 2017 USA ARDF Championships. I entered three of the four medal events; 80 Meter Foxoring, 2 Meter Classic, and 80 Meter Classic . The fourth event was 80 Meter Sprints. This was the first time I have entered an 80 Meter event and had just received an 80 meter receiver made in the Ukraine.


International ARDF events are on foot with handheld receivers. Five transmitters are placed in a forest of at least 1000 acres with minimum separations of 400 meters. The five transmitters are on the same frequency with each transmitting for one minute in sequence using code on AM. A sixth beacon transmits to locate the finish line. Starts are made by mixed groups at five minute intervals. Time limits were 2-3 hours during which time one can expect to cover 4-7 miles in unknown forests. Topographical maps are only given out at the start showing area limits and start and finish lines.. There are eight age groups for males, M13-M70, and seven for women, W13-W60. I was in the M70 group. The younger groups have to find more transmitters than the older groups. I was able to place third in M70 Foxoring and 2 Meter Classic events. I withdrew from the 80 Meter Classic event when rain seeped into my receiver causing spurious tone reception.
