





Recent changes to Call Signs in use for the past 20 to 40 years! By Larry W1VP

With the Vanity Call Sign program offered by the FCC, we can change our FCC issued Amateur Radio Call Signs to one of our own choosing. Of course we must adhere to the prefix and structural rules defined by our license class. Also in some cases, we must wait for specific Call Sign availability and time the FCC application submission to **just** the right date. This assures we successfuly 'compete' against other hams who also want that particular Call Sign, issued using random selection. This date-critical submission is for the more sought after 1x2 and 2x1 Call Signs available to Amateur Extra class operators. Often numerious attempts for 1x2 and 2x1 calls are needed.

Recently, several local Amateur Extra class operators sucessfully changed their Call Signs to one of these 1x2 or 2x1 calls. That in itself is not unusual – but these local hams have switched from their original FCC issued Call Signs they've had for some 20 to 40 years! **Best of luck with the new calls!!**
